

Scholarship Packet

Through the KCA Construction Education Foundation, the Kansas Contractors Association offers scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$2,500 for any Kansas student enrolled or intending to enroll for the 2024–2025 school year in a field related to heavy & highway construction at an accredited Kansas university, community college or technical college. *What is heavy construction? Think of "planes, trains and automobiles." Heavy construction involves building infrastructure, such as highways, bridges, utilities, railroads and airports.*

Eligibility

- Enrolled or intending to enroll in a Kansas university, community college or technical college for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Enrolled or planning to enroll in a degree program related to a career in heavy construction. Examples include construction management, surveying, heavy equipment operation, welding, bridge/highway engineering or another field of study with the intent to work in the heavy & highway construction industry.

Checklist of Items that Must be Enclosed in Application Packet

Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all the following items are received as one packet by the KCA office

postmarked by January 31, 2024:

- Completed, signed and dated Application Form
- One completed Recommendation Form
- Scholarship Essay
- High school or college transcript

Awards

- The number and dollar amount of awards will be determined by KCA's Construction Education Foundation committee.
- All completed applications will be reviewed by the Construction Education Foundation committee.
- Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the recipient's college or university in their name for disbursement.
- All scholarship winners will be eligible to receive an additional award up to \$2,000 for completing an internship with a KCA member contractor. One recommendation form should be included with your application. Recommendations should include:

- 1. How long has the writer known the applicant
- 2. In what capacity is the writer familiar with the applicant's education and background
- 3. Why the writer believes the applicant would be a good candidate to receive the scholarship

Internship Interest

Scholarship winners will be eligible for an additional award up to \$2,000 if they complete a summer internship with a KCA member contractor. This award would be in addition to wages paid by the company for which you intern.
